Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Srl	Description	Clarification
01	What is the full duration of the B.Ed Program	2-years, comprising 1 st Year and 2 nd Year.
02	What is the maximum duration to complete the B.Ed program	Minimum: 2 years Maximum: 5 years
03	After passing, do I become eligible to teach in school and for which classes	Yes; Classes 9 to 12 as per NCTE. But in reality, only PGTs are given priority, non-PGs are allotted lower classes.
04	Can I be recruited directly to a school for the post of a teacher if I apply	Yes, Possible in a private school's requirement by clearing their interview and demonstration classes.
05	What about joining Schools of State Government or Central Government	You need to clear TET of your State or Central TET and look for new vacancy.
06	How is the Univ Examination conducted	Yearly basis; at the end of 1 st Yr and 2 nd Yr annually.
07	What is the Pass mark in each Paper of University examination	40% in each theory and practical part separately, if paper contains practical portion also, otherwise only on theory only.
08	Is it necessary to pass all papers	Yes; Degree of B.Ed requires that.
09	If I fail in some papers in University Examinations	University conducts Re-examination only for max.2-Papers failure, provided your score is min 45% in other papers. Contact your college within a week of result publication.
10	Do I need to attend regular classes in College to appear at the University examinations	Yes; Minimum 90% in School-Internship and 80% in College classes.
11	What is the time duration to write University Papers in 1 st Year and 2 nd Year	3 hours for 80 marks paper; 2 hours for 40 marks paper.
12	Is there will be options in Questions of University Papers in each year	Yes, plenty. You have to attempt only 5 questions out of 10 questions given.
13	Can an employed teacher join this B.Ed program	Certainly on production of NOC from employer for release of 2 years to attend daily classes. Rest of the procedures is same as non-teachers candidates.
14	Do I need to qualify in Admission Test to join B.Ed program as I am more qualified with a Post Graduate degree	Criteria for admission are controlled by NCTE from time to time and University implements it. College or University may conduct selection test for preparation of merit list, where all applicants have to sit for that test. Minimum qualification is a Bachelors Degree with 50% marks having school subjects with relaxation of 5% marks for reserved categories of SC/STs.
15	I am an engineer with B.Tech Degree but desire to be a school teacher. Can I join this program	Yes, if your final score is min 55% with proof of having Science and Mathematics papers in B.Tech.

16	What are the break-ups of teaching Practice sessions of University Paper of SIP (School-Internship Program).	Details: Teaching 2 Method school subjects in a Government nominated school for B.Ed students in a college. <u>4 week in 1st Yr:</u> 10 working days in College classes for skill development +18 working days in Practice School with a Supervisor teacher. <u>16 week in 2nd Yr:</u> In Practice School with Supervisor teacher.
17	Is it mandatory to visit school for Practice teaching as a B.Ed student, if I am already having earlier experience as a teacher	Yes, this is compulsory for all students enrolled for B.Ed Program irrespective of teacher-background.

19	Is this B.Ed program Internationally accepted for jobs and higher studies	Yes. For South Asian Countries, Indian UGC degrees are well accepted. But for USA, Australia and Europe, you may have to obtain an equivalence certificate from their approved bodies. On the basis of that a license will be issued in your name as a professional teacher for employment or acquiring higher degrees. In India, presently Physicians, Architects and Lawyers are holding statutory registration number for self-practice and jobs.
20	I am not very efficient in written and spoken English; Can I study and appear university examinations through Hindi medium	Yes, University accepts both Hindi and English scripts for writing the papers, except other Indian language papers.
21	What are other job avenues for B.Ed holders	Following establishments recruit B.Ed candidates: Educational Recruiting Co, Foreign embassies, NGOs, Survey Agencies, Marketing Research, Govt Projects, UNESCO,HR consultancy.
