Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Srl	Description	Clarification
01	What is the full duration of the Diploma in Elementary Education(D.El.Ed) Program	2-years, comprising 1 st Year and 2 nd Year curriculum.
02	What is the maximum duration to complete the D.El.Ed program	Minimum: 2 years Maximum: 3 years as per NCTE norms
03	What is popular PTT Examination	PTTE is Primary Teachers Training Examination conducted by JAC in Jharkhand State.
04	Who is eligible to appear this PTT Examination	PTTE is conducted by State Secondary Board or Primary Education Council for regular students on completion of 2 years D.El.Ed Program from college.
05	So PTTE and D.El.Ed are the same	Yes , very much. As per JAC, PTTE is the name of examination, where as D.El.Ed is nationally accepted name of the Course/Program. Earlier it was called Basic Training (BT) in many training colleges.
06	How is the D.El.Ed Examinations conducted	As per JAC published Syllabus, Yearly 2 Semester Examinations, i.e., total 4 semesters are to be conducted in 2 years but it is not implemented yet;
07	What is the prevailing system of Examination	Present system is annual examinations conducted by College and One final PTT Exam after completion of 2 years. So total 3 examinations (2 by College+1 by JAC).
08	How can I get the syllabus	You can get the Outline of Papers in our website ; For full content of syllabus buy a JAC published book or contact your Principal for availing a photocopy-set.
09	How the syllabus is framed by JAC	It is on the basis of Yearly content. If your college follows Semester method then 50% content to be covered, otherwise full 1 st Yr or 2 nd Yr content, as the case may be for annual examination of college.
10	After passing, do I become eligible to teach in school and for which classes	Yes; Classes 1 to 8 as per NCTE. But in reality, only TGTs (Bachelor degree+ B.Ed) are given priority, PTTCs are allotted lower classes in Private schools.
11	Can I be recruited directly to a school for the post of a teacher if I apply	Yes, Possible in a private school's requirement by clearing their interview and demonstration classes.
12	What about joining Schools of State Government or Central Government	You need to clear TET of your State or Central TET and look for new vacancy. Some

		states/KVs/NVs conduct Primary SSC also, you can apply for same.
13	How is the Board(JAC) Examination conducted	Till now at the end of 2 years covering full 2 year syllabus; Out of 1400 marks of 14 papers.
14	What is the Pass mark in each Paper of JAC/College examinations	40% in each theory and practical part separately (if paper contains practical portion), otherwise only on theory only, irrespective of external or internal tests.
15	Is it necessary to pass all papers	Yes; Diploma of El. Education/PTTE requires that.
16	What is the importance of College Annual Examinations	College sends the average of Internal marks of each Paper of 2 Annual Examinations to JAC as per rules
17	If I fail in some papers in JAC Examinations	Board conducts Re-examination only in the next year as ex-Regular candidate. Contact your college within a week of result publication for details.
18	Do I need to attend regular classes in College to appear at the JAC examinations	Yes; Minimum 75% as per JAC but our college, MITT expects 100% attendance from students.
19	What is the time duration to write JAC Final or College Papers in 1 st Year and 2 nd Year	Enquire from the College Principal
20	Is there will be options in Questions of JAC Papers in each year	Most probably Yes. Collect the previous year's QPs from your seniors or from Library or from bookstores.
21	Can an employed teacher join this D.El.Ed program	Certainly on production of NOC from employer for release of 2 years to attend daily classes. Rest of the procedures is same as non-teachers candidates.
21	Do I need to qualify in Admission Test to join D.El.Ed program because I am more qualified than CI-12 with a Post Graduate /Graduate degree	Criteria for admission are controlled by NCTE from time to time and JAC implements it. College and/or JAC may conduct Selection Test for preparation of merit list, where all applicants have to sit for that test. Minimum qualification is a Class-12 pass with 50% marks having school subjects with relaxation of 5%marks for reserved categories of SC/STs etc with 45% marks.
22	Tell me details of JAC examination papers to write after 2 years	Ten Theory Papers(60x10=600);Paper-11(40 marks);Paper-13(60marks):total 690.Rest 710 marks will be from college internals; Grand total will be 1400 from 14 papers.
23	What is 1 st Divn in D.El.Ed examination	You have to score (60%); minimum 840 out of 1400; having 14 papers of 100 each.
24	Is there any campus placement opportunity	Yes, if you are regular and your scoring marks of Internal examinations are consistently good; College may recommend you for opportunities in Private Schools through placement cell.
