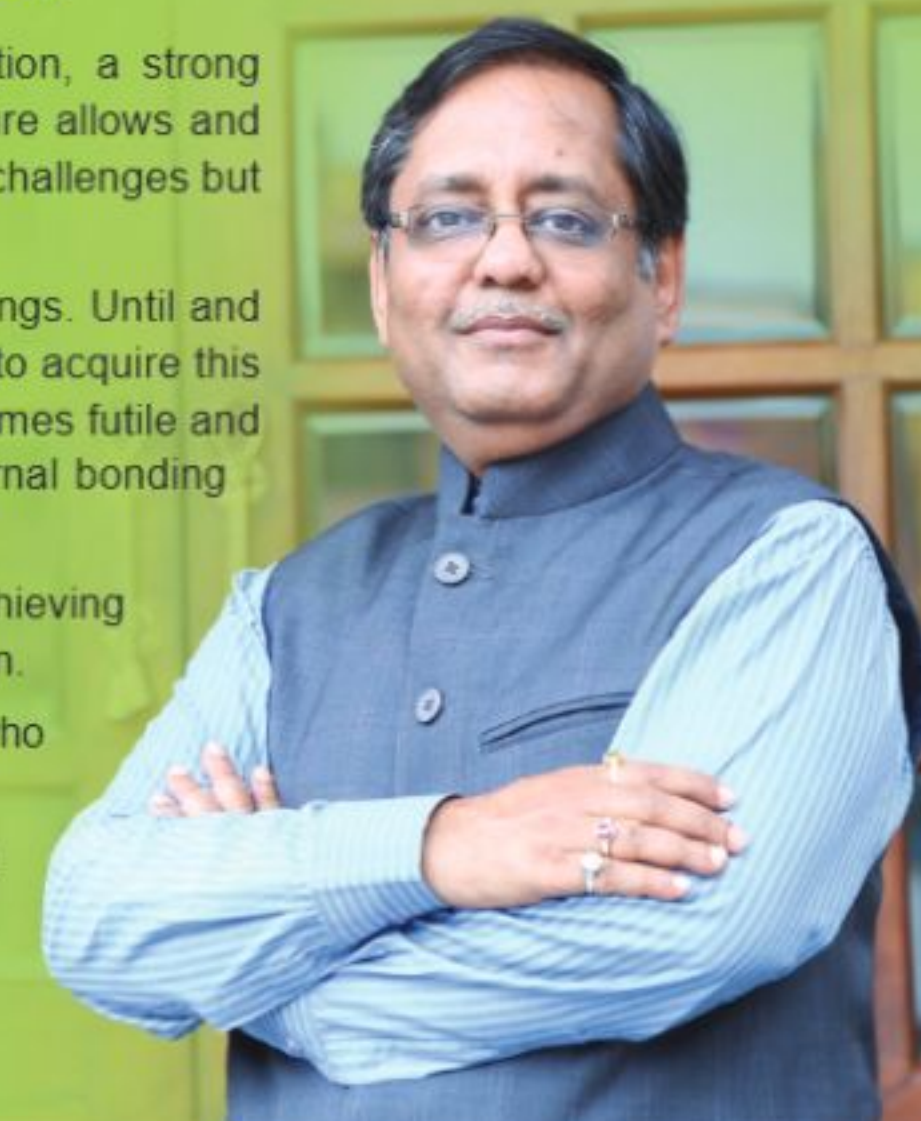

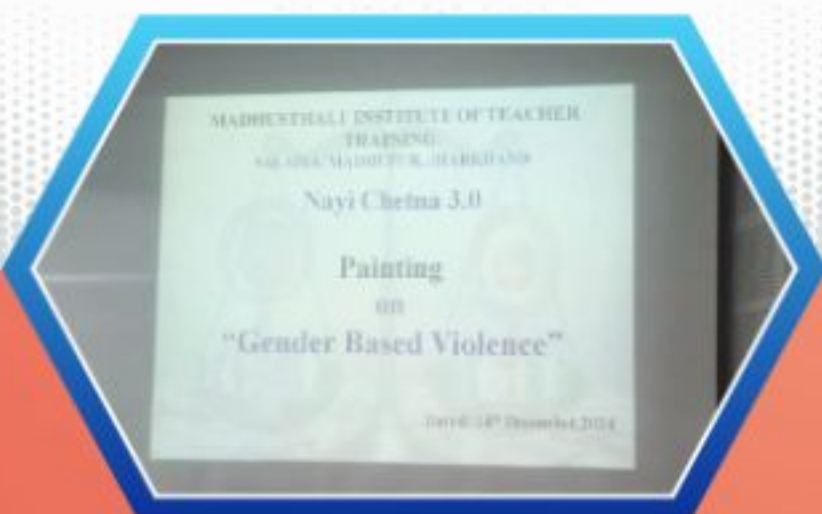
GROUP DISCUSSION
